

TOWN OF LEON
CONCEALED CARRY ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Leon, Monroe County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title

This ordinance is entitled the "Town of Leon Concealed Carry Ordinance".

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to ban firearms in the town hall and shop area, both concealed and open carry.

Section 3. Authority

2011 Wisconsin Act 35 on Concealed Carry and Open Carry of weapons. Wisconsin Statutes 175.60(2); 175.60(1)(f); 175.60(1)(j); 175.60(1); 66.0409(6); 66.0409(3)(b); 175.60(15m); 175.60(16) and 175.60(21) also apply.

Section 4. Provisions of Ordinance

The Town of Leon does hereby by ban concealed or open carry firearms in the Leon Town Hall and the Leon Town Shop located at 8108 Jackrabbit Avenue, Sparta, WI 54656. Signs to the provision shall be posted at primary entrance(s) to the town hall/shop.

Section 5. Penalty Provision

The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall consist of two steps. Step 1 is for 1st offence, a letter indicating that carrying weapons into town hall/shop is not allow and warning that a future violation may lead to Step 2. Step 2 will impose a penalty of \$25.00

Section 6. Severability

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

Section 7. Effective Date

Following passage by the Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect after the date of publication or posting as provided by sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
